## Material and finish

Wire nails shall be made of steel (grade at manufacturer's discretion) and have a bright (bk)1) or galvanized (zn)1) finish.

## Form of supply

Wire nails shall be supplied in packs.

Designation for ordering 100 kg of round lost head wire nails of size  $12 \times 20$ , with bright finish (bk):

100 kg nails 12 × 20 DIN 1152 - bk
